Remember and Celebrate: Order of Festivals within Tru lessons

There are a couple of ways we could have ordered these throughout the curriculum. We chose to put the feasts and festivals in the Messianic symbolic order. Many theologians point to the festivals as symbolic eras in the Messianic timeline. Tru has them in the order of New Testament significance of what has been fulfilled and what has yet to be fulfilled.

It's good to note that Scripture doesn't teach these as symbolic—they just are. When you look at Scripture as theologians have we can see symbolism in the feasts by the things God has done throughout time.
